

10 The New Testament: Salvation Unveiled through Jesus, the Prophet, Priest, and King

We have seen how prophets interpret God's Word and show people how it will play out.

We have seen how priests bring offerings as a mediator between man and God.

We have seen how kings bring order and leadership to a nation.

The New Testament presents Jesus as God's prophet (though much more than a prophet).

Matthew chapters 5-7, note the "You have heard . . . I say to you . . ." statements

Deuteronomy 18 a prophet like Moses, Matthew 17, God calls people to hear Jesus

The New Testament presents Jesus as the one who makes offering and is the mediator.

Romans chapter 5

1 Timothy 2:5

Hebrews chapter 9

The New Testament presents Jesus as the king.

John 18:17

1 Timothy 6:13-16

Acts 7:55-56

How does this work? The New Testament authors present Jesus as both truly God and truly man, without sin, who is able to fulfill all of God's righteousness.
